Henry Wilmerink Is Taken Fol- lowing Admissions Made by William Grady.

On the strength of the admission made by William Grady, arrested on suspicion of burglary and larceny, Detectives Sturgis and O'Leary Monday night arrested Henry Wilmerink, lodging him in a cell at headquarters on a similar charge. The officers allege the pair forced an entrance and looted the warehouse of the Au Sable Power company.

A stranger giving the name of Elmer Youngblood was taken into custody Monday night by Patrolman Wanner and lodged at headquarters. He is being detained while the detectives investigate him.

JITNEY BUS DRIVER IS ARRESTED AND PAYS COSTS

The first jitney bus driver has been arrested, arraigned in Police court and fined for his violation of the traffic rules. Autocop Stiegenga Monday arrested Lee Blanchard, proprietor of the Blanchard jitney bus line, and Judge Hess assessed him the costs.

When Blanchard was first arraigned he pleaded not guilty. The officer charged that Blanchard had driven his big car around a street car that was discharging and taking on passengers in Division avenue, S. Blanchard prepared for trial but through the good offices of Assistant City Attorney Shaw, the respondent changed his plea, later in the day and was sentenced.
